She served on the board of Deloitte & Touche LLP US (overseeing the US audit, tax, financial advisory and consulting businesses), where she served on the Partner Affairs, Nominating, Compensation, and Strategic Investments Committees. Hayley served as EVP at UnitedHealthcare, where as a direct report to the CEO, she led a program to develop a new strategy to reinvent members' healthcare experience and move UHC to a new business model. She also led a program to reduce the operating cost in the back office and had responsibility for the relationship with the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services.
